If you are a senior student (i.e., you will complete your degree by June of 2017) at FI-UNAM, and you are interested in doing research and in the future pursuing a PhD at the Viterbi School of Engineering at USC ("Doctorado Directo"), you may qualify to participate a summer research internship at the University of Southern California.

The requirements are (i) excellent grade point average in the top 10% of you class, (ii) excellent English skills, and (iii) taking the GRE exam before starting the program. This project is co-funded by UNAM and USC. If you are selected, your transportation and living expenses are covered by the program.

Many of the students that participated in the summer internships in previous years have already started their PhD's at USC funded by a collaborative agreement with CONACYT.

This program is open to all the Engineering Programs of the Engineering School.
